Home Facility Data is any data delivered to the HIE directly from the organization (or an organization within the hierarchy) associated with the user's InContext or Portal account. The Structured Document subtab is located within the Clinical Data tab. The filter will be on by default.

Users can click the filter icon and select the check box next to 'Hide Home Facility Data' to add/remove this filter. A grey 'Hide Home Facility Data' text box will appear above the data table to indicate that this filter is applied or not on the data table.

Prior to this release: The Medication Management tab did not contain Reported Medications from CCDs in Maryland.

For this release: A new tab titled 'Reported Medications' will be added to the Medication Management section of the InContext/Clinical Information Service Application. Reported Medications provides the patient's medication data received from Consolidated Clinical Documents (CCDs) sent to the HIE. The 'Reported Medications' tab contains a data table with the following fields: Generic Name, Medication Name, Dose, Sig, Provider, Start Date, and Last Reported Date. Medications will be displayed in a 90-day view as well as a full historical lookback.

A 'definitions of key terms' button has been added to the side of the table and can be clicked to expand.

Please Note: Reported Medications data is sourced from electronic medical records shared with CRISP. This is not necessarily all prescribed medications and may not reflect a patient's complete medication list.
