

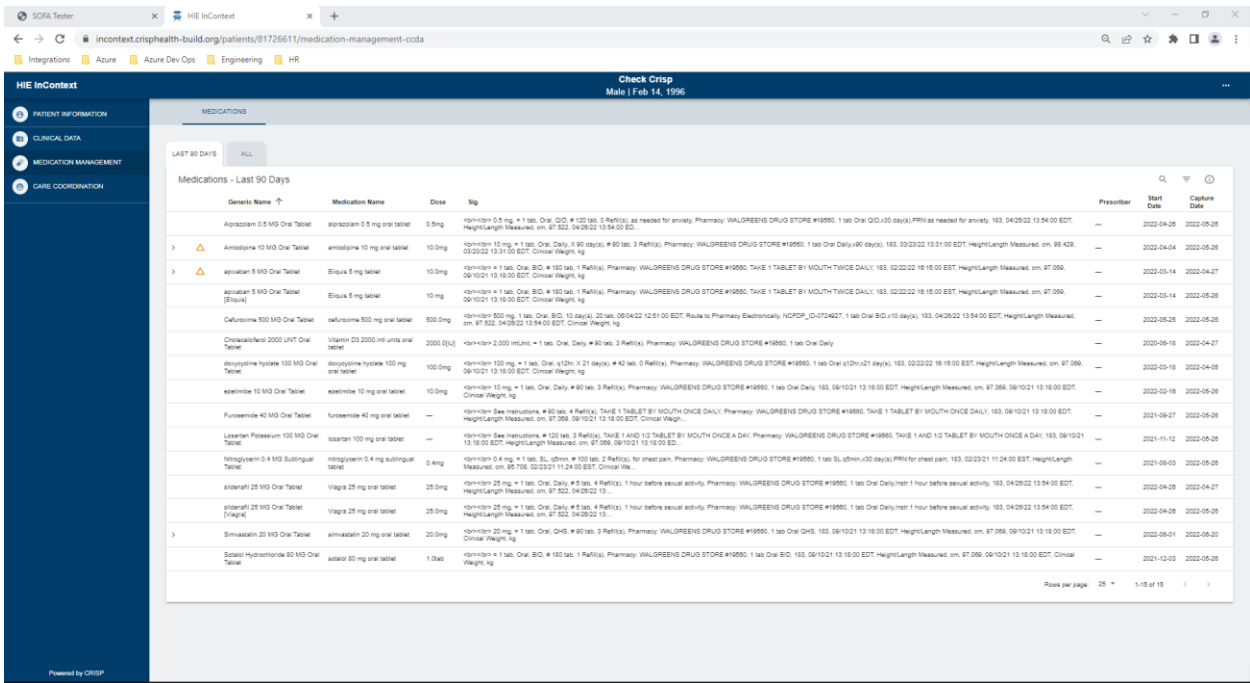

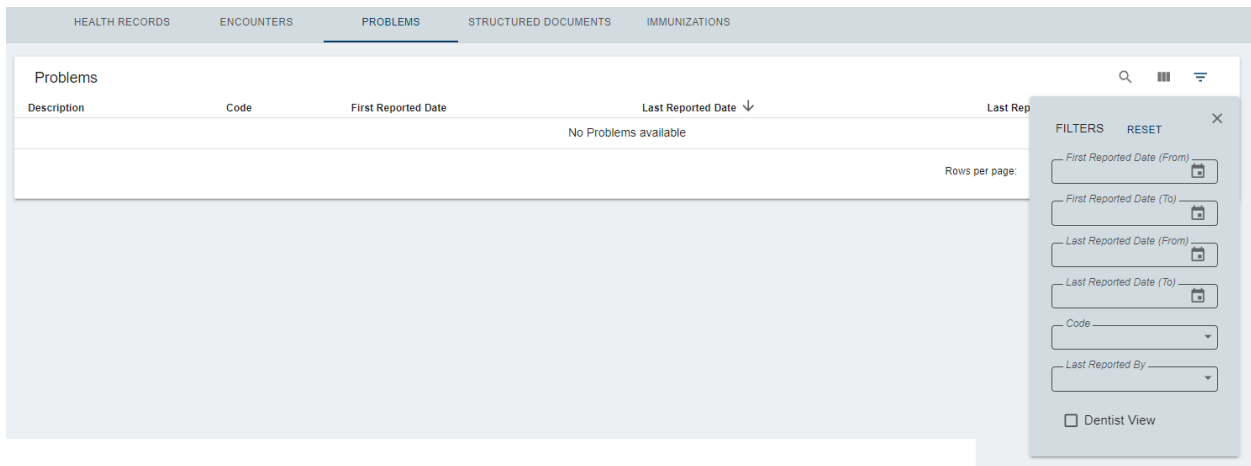
New interface:
