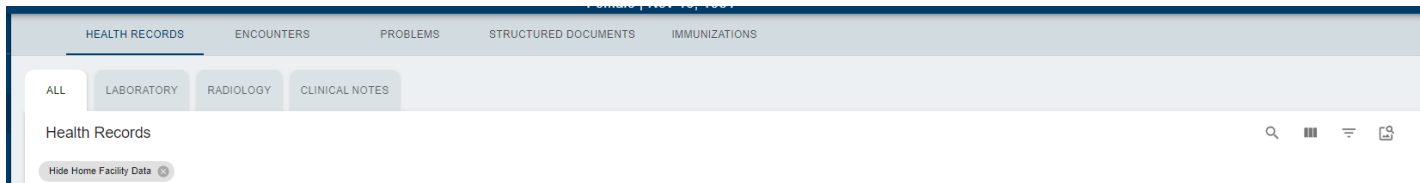
Hide home faculty data icon should be self-explainable to the user

Affected HIEs: CRISP MD

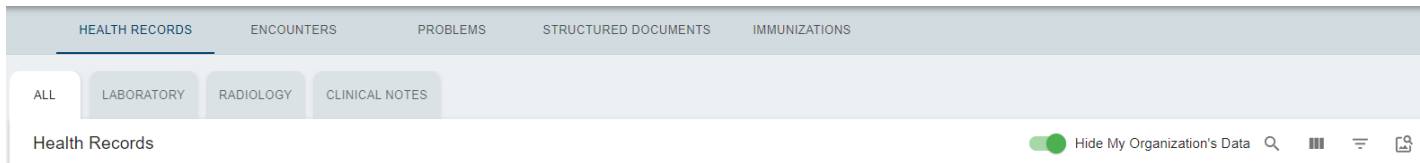
Prior to this release: The “Hide Home Faculty Data” icon did not produce a pop-up to explain its function to the user.

Hide COVID Lab Tools SSO functionality

Affected HIEs: WVHIN

Prior to this release: All HIEs could see “COVID Lab Tools” in the Apps section, which allows for the reporting of COVID test results.

After this release: Only WVHIN will continue to see the “COVID Lab Tools” as that HIE is still reporting the test results to the state. Users will still see the tool even if they’ve opted-out of the HIE.
