Our latest version of the HIE InContext app (**v.2.44.0**) has been **deployed to test**. See the screenshots below for details.

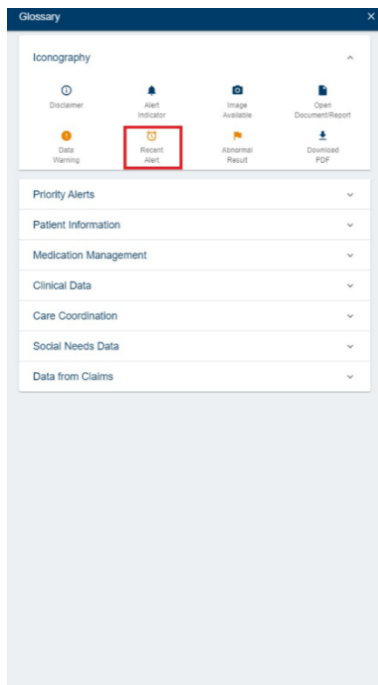

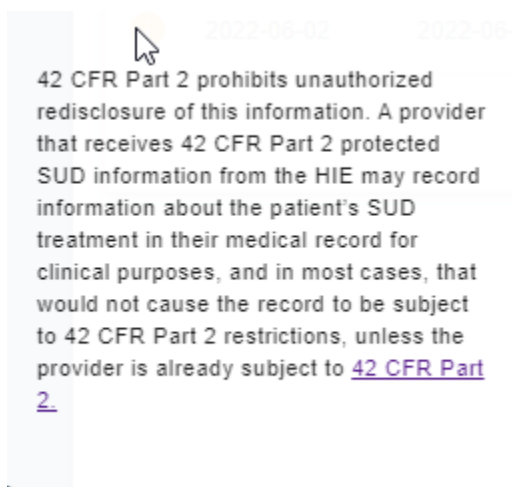

After this release: Relevant SUD information will display on all subtabs when users hover over each title (eg. Procedures, Medications, and Diagnoses) under the Data from Claims main tab.



Display State Source Info

Affected HIEs: WVHIN and CRISP MD

After this release: Display a new column in the Data from Claims tab labeled “State Source” with the subtabs mentioned above. This update will also replace the Payer column in the Encounter subtab with a “State Source” title. The plan is to let InContext users access where the claim originated.
